#### NB PROVINCIAL HIGHLIGHTS



#### Introduction

MQO Research spoke with 400 residents of New Brunswick to gauge the political temperature in the province for the Summer edition of our quarterly political poll: Atlantic Matters.

#### **Provincial Politics**

According to the latest polling numbers, the PC Party has widened their lead heading into the election. Among decided and leaning voters:

- PC Party support increased by 6 percentage points to 43%.
- Liberal support dropped by 4 percentage points to 27%.
- Support for the Green Party dropped by 4 percentage points to 17%
- o Support for the People's Alliance held relatively steady at 5%.
- o NDP support was relatively unchanged at 6%.

The Atlantic Matters poll was conducted by telephone from August  $25^{th}$  to August  $30^{th}$ , 2020 and included 400 randomly selected eligible voters from across the province. The margin of error for the total sample is  $\pm$  4.9 percentage points 19 times out of 20.




