

Summer 2020 Provincial Report Newfoundland and Labrador



Introduction

MQO Research spoke with 400 residents of Newfoundland and Labrador to gauge the political temperature in the province for the Summer edition of our quarterly political poll: Atlantic Matters.

Provincial Politics

According to the latest polling numbers, the Liberals have a double-digit lead over the PCs. Among decided and leaning voters:

- Support for the Liberal Party increased by 12 percentage points to 53%.
- PC Party support dropped 4 percentage points to 33%.
- NDP support dropped 7 percentage points to 11%.
- Support for the NL Alliance held steady at 1%.

The Atlantic Matters poll was conducted by telephone from August 19th to September 6th, 2020 and included 400 randomly selected eligible voters from across the province. The margin of error for the total sample is ± 4.9 percentage points 19 times out of 20.

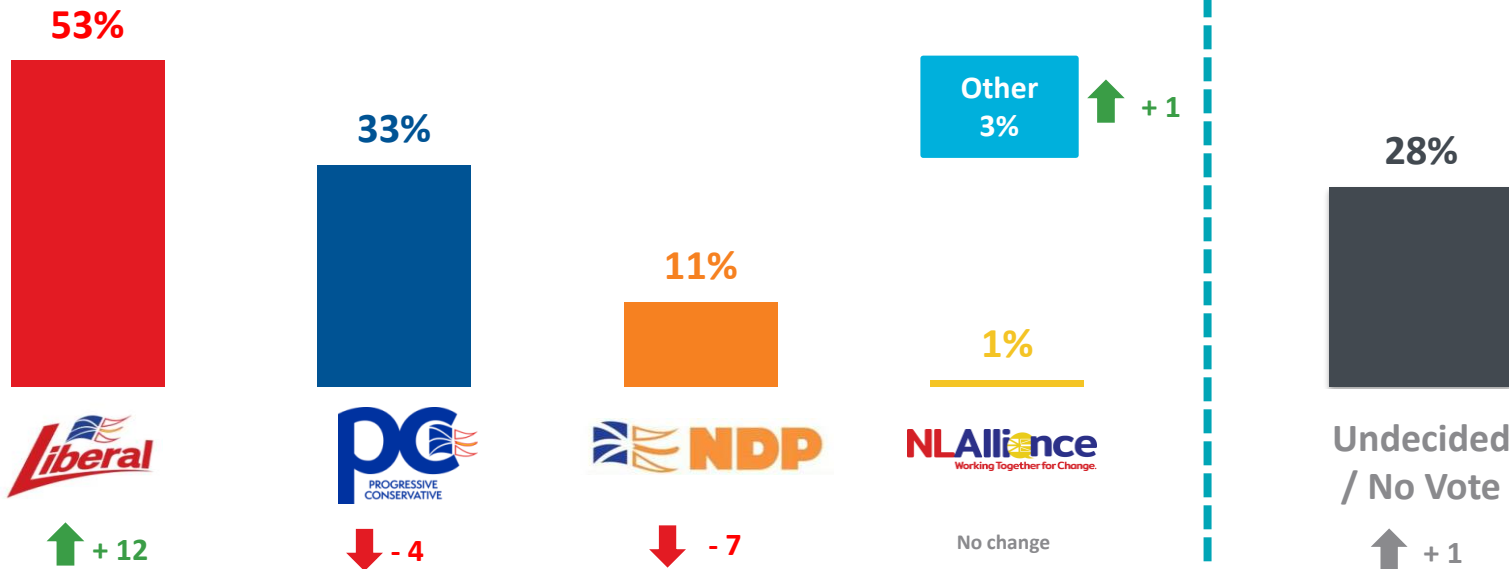
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“If a provincial election were held today, which party would you most likely vote for?”

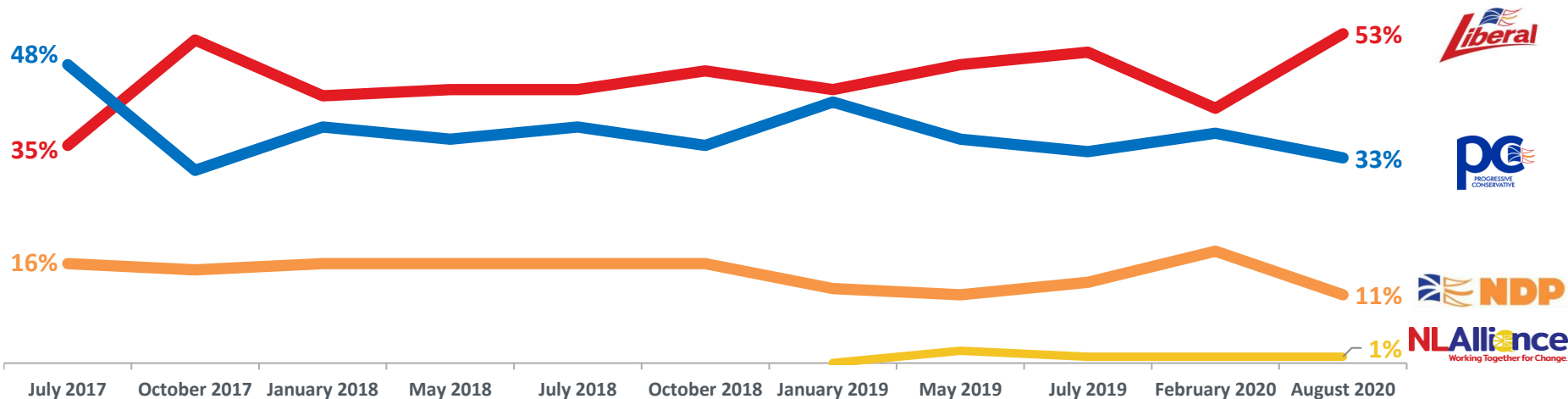
Decided and Leaning Voters
